



Immediate Implants in the Aesthetic Zone: Know When to Load, Know When to Hold

Over the past 30 years, dental implant therapy has changed dramatically. When faced with the loss of an anterior tooth, patients were forced to wait more than a year for the treatment to be completed. This is not the case any longer. Now, teeth can be reliably replaced “Immediately”. The challenge is knowing when to place implants immediately, when to place a provisional restoration and how to train the tissue to look as if the replacement is a natural tooth. This presentation will provide a decision tree based on diagnostic and biologic principles to be used in a team approach to provide excellent aesthetic care. We will discuss:

- The biologic principles of mapping and diameter driven treatment planning
- How to recognize the different tissue biotypes and provide strategies for managing peri-implant hard and soft tissues
- The process of fabricating and managing provisional restorations for the development of an ideal soft tissue environment.
- The different material choices available for restorations in the aesthetic zone.
- How to identify and manage potential complications that may occur in providing dental implant therapy in the aesthetic zone.

Speaker: Gary A. Morris, DDS

Dr. Morris completed his undergraduate studies at Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana. He received his dental degree from the University of Illinois at Chicago and completed his residency in Prosthodontics at the UMKC College of Dentistry in Kansas City Missouri. He is an Adjunct Clinical Assistant Professor at Southern Illinois University, School of Dental Medicine. Prior to this appointment he was a Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of Illinois, College of Dentistry.
