

Occlusion, Delivery Procedures and Management of Complications

Occlusion is a controversial subject in dentistry on its own. Add dental implants into the mix and it becomes quite complicated. Teeth and dental implants differ in many ways. The periodontal ligament is absent around implants, teeth drift and shift with craniofacial change while dental implants remain stationary. Strategies must be in place to accommodate these differences.

- Learn how to maintain a patient after dental implant therapy is complete
