# February 18, 2022 Enhanced Aesthetics with Crowns, Veneers and Implant Prosthetics

Many patients visit our practices just for a better look to their smile. Cosmetic dentistry has evolved into an integral element of contemporary dental practice. We must develop the ability to evaluate existing cosmetic deficiencies and recognize patient expectations to design proper procedure for smile improvement. This evaluation can involve implants, single or multiple-unit, orthodontic spacers designed to increase a space or veneers. By taking all these possibilities into account, aesthetics can be improved. The preparation and materials used are to be part of the aesthetics and function. Provisional techniques, longevity, and cementation methods for various materials will be discussed.

# May 13, 2022 Now What? Occlusion, Delivery Procedures & Management of Complications

Occlusion is a controversial subject in dentistry on its own, add dental implants into the mix and it becomes quite complicated. Teeth and dental implants differ in many ways. The periodontal ligament is absent around implants, teeth drift and shift with craniofacial change while dental implants remain stationary. Strategies must be in place to accommodate these differences.
