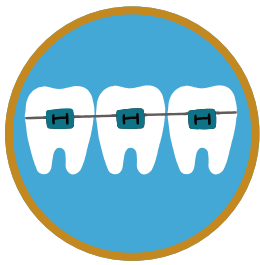
## **Risk Management: Growing a Culture of Prevention**

Participants will learn the current state of dental malpractice litigation, general and particular risks that can lead to litigation, and best practices to prevent a claim or provide the best defense to a claim.

### **Course Objectives:**

- Identify common risks particular to dental malpractice claims.
- Learn how to prevent these risks by implementing team practices and processes.
- Employ learned steps to minimize areas of dental risk and develop communication and documentation strategies for standard and high-risk aspects of practice.

### Full Arch Treatment Planning & Advancements

Full arch therapy is not new to the dental community. But workflows rapidly change. This course will describe the pros and cons of digital and analog workflows in full arch treatment plans.

- To be able to plan full arch cases in both workflows for best patient outcomes.
