Course Topics & Objectives

Dr. Katie Graber

Dr. Graber will discuss multi-disciplinary case planning as well as Suresmile 3D technology.

Objectives:

1. To diagnose and formulate multi-disciplinary treatment plans for orthodontic cases—including the management of anterior bonding, Bolton discrepancies, and missing teeth while determining the optimal timing for referral in mixed dentition cases with missing teeth and evaluating advanced surgical and MARPE case examples.
 2. To demonstrate the benefits of Suresmile 3D technology in our practice in how it benefits our patients in terms of treatment efficiency, root/bone health, efficient planning and communication of treatment plans.

4. To discuss impaction cases, highlighting when to refer and the process for addressing impaction with team approach.



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
